Camea is best known for her hypnotic, floor grinding Avant-garde techno and house DJ sets. Her relentless passion for track digging and innate ability to read and energize crowds keep her on the move, and she has been an undeniable force in dance music for over twenty years. Coming from a classical music background in Seattle, she started DJing in the late 90s in dark, West Coast rave warehouses, then immersed herself in New York in Brooklyn's clandestine techno scene, where she threw regular basement events and started one of the minimal eras most illustrious labels, Clink Recordings. Her label and studio work inevitably put her on the main stage, and she found her heart through touring when she landed in Berlin in 2006, where she has been centered in the electronic music scene for over ten years, regularly moving dance floors in the city's vast selection of no-nonsense, subterranean clubs and festivals. She is known as a master selector and has a monthly, cult podcast called Neverwhere Radio, growing a loyal international audience and keeping listeners engaged with her non-compromising aesthetic of underground dance music. Camea is a master of telling stories through music, and her devotion to DJing and mastering her craft speaks through her skillful sets, often changing tempos and moods to keep her audiences captivated.

Inspired by her love for jacking warehouse-style techno and house, Camea launched her second record label in 2015, Neverwhere Records, featuring her own production and the work of artists like Matrixxman, Markus Suckut, Tobias., LA-4A, Ian Pooley, Andre Kronert and more. Furthermore, she is famously known as a mainstay artist on Berlin's legendary Bpitch Control imprint, releasing and touring alongside Ellen Allien for many years. Camea's nonstop gig schedule and lengthy discography of over forty releases and remixes speaks for itself, and she has proven herself a force to be reckoned with many times over.
